Can you find the two adjectives in this sentence?

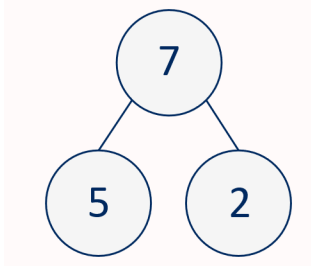
The small penguin was wllaking with his red kite.

Can you now write some of your own sentences about your weekend making sure you use time connectives, adjectives and nouns.

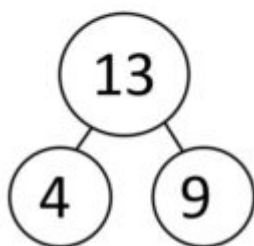
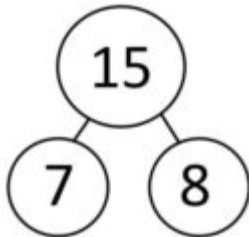
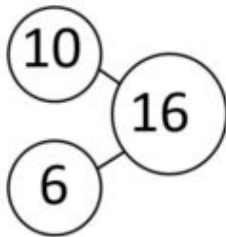
## Maths
