


Number Line and Digit Formation

Number line: The children use many different resources and representations of number at school. This is a number line that they are familiar with using. It helps with digit formation, counting on, counting back and with recognising Numicon number shapes.



Digit formation: These are the digit writing rhymes we teach the children at school.

Remember, one digit in a square!

Have you checked that all of your digits are formed the right way round?

<p>All the way round, what a herot That's the number zero.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">0</p> <p>zero</p>	<p>Top to the bottom, now it's done. That's the way we write a one.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">1</p> <p>one</p>	<p>A curl for me and a line for you. That's the way we write a two.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">2</p> <p>two</p>	<p>A curl for you and a curl for me. That's the way we write a three.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">3</p> <p>three</p>	<p>Down, across and then one more. That's the way we write a four.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">4</p> <p>four</p>	<p>Hat on top, take a dive and round we go. That makes a five.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">5</p> <p>five</p>
<p>Down it goes and give it a mix. That's the way we write a six.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">6</p> <p>six</p>	<p>Across and down, so easy it's heaven. This is the way we write a seven.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">7</p> <p>seven</p>	<p>Draw an S and close the gate. That's the way we write an eight.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">8</p> <p>eight</p>	<p>Round we go and draw a line. That's the way we write a nine.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">9</p> <p>nine</p>	<p>Draw a line and round again. This is the way we write a ten.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">10</p> <p>ten</p>
