Home Learning Expectations

- **Home Learning** - set on Mondays. Tasks will be set on maths.co.uk or SPAG.com (log-ins are in planners).

PE day – Monday mornings

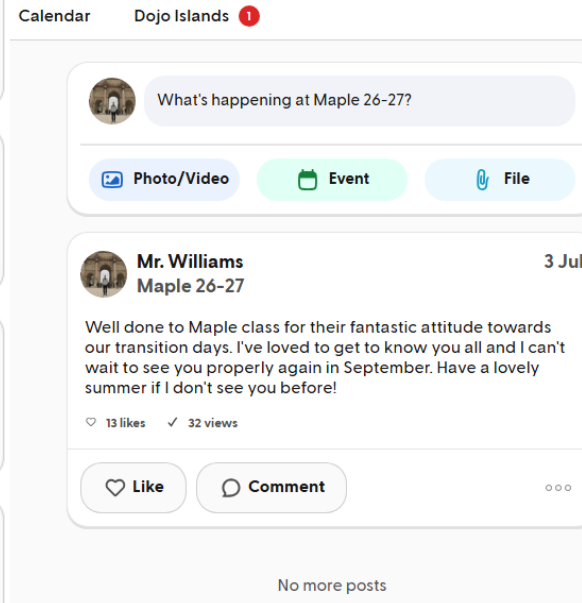
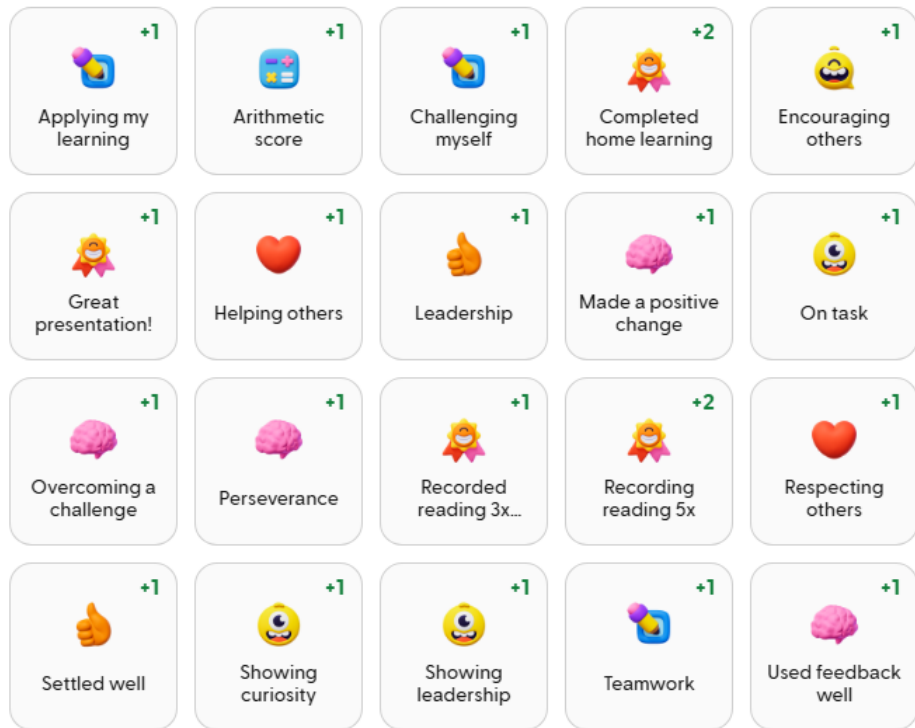
- ▶ Pupils will have a designated PE session on a Monday morning with Jack and Evan from Ace Sports
