No vehicles will be allowed on site during these times except for blue badge holders.

Blue Badges

Please could we remind Blue Badge holders they **must**:

- be unaccompanied when driving the vehicle on site (*unless the other passenger also holds a Blue Badge*)
- drive **very** slowly (5mph) along the driveway and give way to pedestrians and cyclists
- park in a marked bay/ in a sensible way so as to not block traffic flow

- display access permit when vehicle is on site

The schools reserve the right to withdraw an Access Pass at any time, when these terms are not complied with.
If you drive on site please ensure you stick to the 5mph speed limit, this is for the safety of our children and pedestrians.

Clocks changing & Clubs

Now the clocks have change to winter time, it is darker when we travel to and from school. Please could we remind families that if their child attend clubs that a parent accompanies the child until an adult receives them in the morning and an adult collects them after the club finishes at the end of the day.

Please could we remind you of the following:

- Ensure all items of your child's clothing are labelled.
- Please send your child into school with weather appropriate clothing.
- Send your child into school with a water bottle (Please do not send children with energy drinks or water in such bottles, eg. Prime bottles).

School Driveway

Please can we remind pedestrians to use the paths when walking up to school. The school driveway is to be used for vehicles and bikes only. This is to ensure the safety of our children when travelling to and from school. Thank you for your co-operation.

Parking outside the school gate

Parking outside school continues to be problematic. Please could we ask that you are considerate towards our neighbours and other road users when parking. **Do not** park or drop off in the yellow zig zag zone and double yellow lined arteas.
