Dear Parents.

Excitingly, Year 6 have planned a visit to **The Natural History Museum in London on Thursday, 23<sup>th</sup> November 2023**, in order to support the geography learning in our next project *Islands of Fire* (as well as many other aspects of our Year 6 science curriculum).

The Natural History Museum gives the children an opportunity to take a journey through our spectacular Earth and find out more about the tremendous forces that shape our planet. On this trip, children will be able to explore the museum's many fascinating galleries and exhibitions.

We will leave school shortly after **7:30am** and will return at **approximately 5:30pm:** for safeguarding reasons, all children must be collected promptly at this time, unless we advise otherwise. We will keep you updated as to our exact arrival time (plus information about delays) via the school's text messaging service and school website.

We have attempted to keep prices low and have negotiated a discounted price of £14.20. This is a valuable experience for the children so please do support us by sending payment and returning the reply slip by <u>Friday 10th November 2023.</u>

On the day of the trip, your child needs to:

- wear school uniform
- bring a lightweight raincoat and rucksack
- bring a disposable packed lunch, snacks and drinks (not fizzy)

Children may bring a small amount of pocket money (£5 maximum) to spend in the museum's gift shop.

We hope that you will feel able to support this trip; contributions are voluntary but, as our education budget does not cover the cost of off-site visits, if we cannot cover the cost of the trip, then we will, reluctantly, have to cancel it. If you wish to discuss payment by instalments, please speak to the school Office team.

We are able to offer your child a picnic lunch, at a cost of £3.00. Please indicate this on the form below. These must be ordered and paid for in advance as you will not be able to order one on the day of the trip. If your child is entitled to a free school meal we can provide a picnic lunch for them, free of charge. Please also indicate this on the form below.
