



## Handwriting at Foxhills



This set of ten learning videos will prodominantly support handwriting for children in years one and two, however, may be beneficial for some children, during the later stages of year R. Children will benefit from these videos once they can hold a pencil accurately, have consolidated initial formation of letters, using the ditties from our phonics programme 'Read, Write, Inc.' and can use letter names as well as the sounds taught in Set 1.
