Blue Badges

Please could we remind Blue Badge holders they must:

- be unaccompanied when driving the vehicle on site (unless the other passenger also holds a Blue Badge)
- drive very slowly (5mph) along the driveway and give way to pedestrians and cyclists
- park in a marked bay/ in a sensible way so as to not block traffic flow
- display access permit when vehicle is on site Please refer to Access Policy for all information regarding use of school site

The schools reserve the right to withdraw an Access Pass at any time, when these terms are not complied with.

If you drive on site please ensure you adhere to the 5mph speed limit, this is for the safety of our children and pedestrians.

Please could we remind you of the following:

- Ensure all items of your child's clothing are labelled.
- Send your child into school with weather appropriate clothing.
- Send your child into school with a water bottle (Please do not send children with energy drinks or water in such bottles, eg. Prime bottles).

Appointments / Late Arrivals

If your child has an appointment or is going to arrive at school after 8.50am you must call or email the school office before the start of the school day.



If your child requires a hot lunch that day please ensure you order this before 9am.
