Dear Parents,

Excitingly, we have been able to secure a visit to **Butser Hill Ancient Farm on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> January**, for Year 3, in order to support the History learning for the spring term.

Butser Hill Ancient farm gives the children an opportunity to take a journey through the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age as well as the Roman Era and find out more about this historical period. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to embed their prior learning of the Stone and Bronze Age, consolidate their learning about the Iron Age (which we are covering this half term) as well as to give some pre learning about the Romans.

We will leave school shortly after **9:00 am** and will return at **approximately 3pm**

We have attempted to keep prices low and the price of the coach is £13.80 and entry to Butser Hill Ancient Hill is £13.60 making the total £27.40. This is a valuable experience for the children so please do support us by **sending payment and returning the reply slip by Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> January.** If you are unable to make a payment by this date then please contact the school office.

On the day of the trip, your child needs to bring:

- wear a school jumper and sensible warm outdoor trousers
- a raincoat and rucksack
- a disposable packed lunch, snacks and drinks (not fizzy)

Children may bring a small amount of pocket money (**£5 maximum**) to spend in the museum's gift shop.

We hope that you will feel able to support this trip; contributions are voluntary but, as our education budget does not cover the cost of off-site visits, if we cannot cover the cost of the trip, then we will, reluctantly, have to cancel it. If you wish to discuss payment by instalments, please speak to the school Office team.

We are able to offer your child a picnic lunch, at a cost of **£3.00**. Please indicate this on the form below. These must be ordered and paid for in advance as you will not be able to order one on the day of the trip. If your child is entitled to a free school meal we can provide a picnic lunch for them, free of charge. Please also indicate this on the form below.
